Sparrow, Samuel. *Marseilles, All's well, that ends well, [IV,4, by Shakespeare]*. [Great Britain?: s.n., 1811?] Folger ART File M364.6 no. 2 (size XS)

All's Well That Ends Well is one of Shakespeare's few plays to take place wholly in continental Europe. Helen must travel to Paris, Florence, Marseilles, and Rossillion (Roussillon). The Marseilles scene (Act 5, Scene 1), often cut from productions, is a scene of delay and disappointment: although Helen and her companions seek the King, "The King's not here" (5.1.24).
