Helen in her pilgrim's costume watches the victorious army parade in Act 3, Scene 5 with the Widow and her daughter, Diana. The Dalziel brothers have unusually focused this depiction on the female observers, not showing Rossillion, the focus of the women's comments: "He, That with the plume. 'Tis a most gallant fellow. I would he loved his wife. If he were honester, He were much goodlier" (3.5.92-95).
