Shakespeare's First Folio (*Mr. William Shakespeares comedies, histories, & tragedies: published according to the true originall copies.* London: Isaac Jaggard and Edward Blount, 1623) contained thirty-six of Shakespeare's plays. Grouped into categories of comedies, histories, and tragedies, *As You Like It* can be found in the comedies, following *The Merchant of Venice.* No manuscript copies of any Shakespeare play are known to have survived, and no edition of *As You Like It* was published during Shakespeare's lifetime. Without the First Folio, this play would have been lost.
