An image of the late-medieval king Edward III, as imagined by former theater manager Thomas Hailes Lacy for *Lacy's Dramatic Costumes*. Printed in London in 1868, the full run of Lacy's collection consisted of over 200 plates of male costumes, originally uncolored. This series followed a similar run of female costumes, published in 1865. The Folger's example was likely hand-colored by a former owner.
