Shakespeare's First Folio (*Mr. William Shakespeares comedies, histories, & tragedies: published according to the true original copies.* London: Isaac Jaggard and Edward Blount, 1623) contained thirty-six of Shakespeare's plays. Grouped into categories of comedies, histories, and tragedies, *The Life of Henry the Fift* can be found in the histories, following *The Second part of K: Henry the fourth*. This was the third play to feature Henry as a protagonist; the first two, named after his father King Henry IV, feature "Prince Hal" before his ascension to the throne.
