



Fitchew, E.H. *Wolsey's Palace*. 1880-1899. Folger ART Box F546.5 no.1 (size S).

This sketch of Wolsey's Palace, also known as Hampton Court Palace, made between 1880 and 1899, indicates the evolving nature of the building that served as a setting for Shakespeare's *King Henry VIII*. The image concentrates on the southwest corner of the palace. The Christopher Wren addition to Hampton Court is sketched in very lightly in pencil. The palace is located about fifteen miles south-west of London, and was occupied by Wolsey from 1514 to 1529.
