

King John prompt book, Shakespeare Under the Stars Festival.

Prompt books are play copies used for specific productions, and contain notes about casting, stage movements, props, and lighting. This prompt book was used in a rare modern production of *King John*, performed in the early 1950s as part of the Shakespeare Under the Stars Festival, also known as the Antioch Shakespeare Festival. The Festival was created by Arthur Lithgow and Meredith Dallas at Antioch College in Yellow Springs, Ohio, in the 1950s.
