This print features American actor John Henry Hackett as Falstaff as he appears near the end of the play, dressed up as Herne the Hunter. Like many other 19th-century Shakespearean actors, Hackett made a career out of portraying a particular character: Hackett was well-known by both American and English audiences for his version of Falstaff. Hackett also published a book, *Notes and Comments on Shakespeare*, in 1863. (*Encyclopedia Brittanica*, 12 (11th ed.) Cambridge University press, p. 794)
