The Duchess, whose husband is a close associate of Henry VI, is caught dabbling in necromancy in an attempt to secure the throne of England for the Duke of Gloucester. In *The Second Part of King Henry VI*, she is one of the many characters throughout the play who try and fail to attain the English throne.
