The Second Part of King Henry VI tracks the simmering conflict between the king and England's nobility, and ends as the war opens with the First Battle of St. Albans. This colored engraving of Act 2, Scene 2 depicts the Earls of Warwick and Salisbury declaring their allegiance to Richard, Duke of York, who will challenge Henry VI for England's throne.
