This pen-and-ink drawing by Robert Anning Bell depicts the drunken carousing of Caliban, Stephano, and Trinculo. Caliban -- who here tastes liquor for the first time -- abandons Prospero for spirits as he sings, "'Ban, 'ban, Ca-caliban/Has a new master" (Act 2, Scene 2, lines 190-91). See these lines pencilled in the margin of the drawing.
