This striking print is one of a series of prints and drawings based on *Timon of Athens* by Wyndham Lewis. Lewis was the founder of Britain's Vorticist movement, which he established as a local alternative to Cubism. Vorticist art is geometric, dynamic, machinic, and abstract: in this print, Lewis packs shapes against Timon's strained central figure.
