John Massey Wright's watercolor depicts *Titus Andronicus*' final scene, the slain of which include Titus, Lavinia, and Tamora, among others. It's likely that this watercolor shows the death of Titus' daughter Lavinia, though it could also show the death of Tamora, as Titus stabs them both.
