This print depicts a late 18th-century Lavinia at the hunt during Act 2, Scene 2. Priscilla Hopkins portrayed Lavinia in this 1776 production early in her career, as her fame was rising. In the mid-1790s, she married the famed actor John Philip Kemble, her third and final husband.
