

Bida, Alexandre, artist. Troilus and Cressida, I, 2, Cressida and Pandarus view passing warriors. 19th century. Folger ART Box B584 no.9

In Alexendre Bida's watercolor, Cassandra and her uncle, Pandarus, observe warriors passing through the streets of Troy after doing battle with the Greeks. In this scene, Pandarus attempts to persuade his niece that Troilus, rather than Hector, is the Trojan hero worthy of her affection.
