When *The Two Noble Kinsmen* was first published in 1634, its title-page listed both Shakespeare and playwright John Fletcher as authors. Highly prolific, many of Fletcher's plays were written in collaboration with other authors, as was common at the time. His other collaborations with Shakespeare include *Henry VIII* and *Cardenio*, a lost play. (McMullan, Gordon.
