In this print, a huntsman guides King Edward from captivity on the lands of the Archbishop of York; Edward prepares to reunite with Richard, Duke of Gloucester (his remaining loyal brother), Lord Hastings, and Sir William Stanley for a final push for the English throne at the Battles of Barnet and Tewkesbury.
