Ellen Terry as she appeared in Henry Irving's 1901 production of Coriolanus at London's Lyceum Theatre. Irving and Terry were classic partners of the turn-of-the-century London stage, and appeared together in many of Shakespeare's plays. Perhaps their most notable partnership was their 1888-89 appearance as the Macbeths, from which John Singer Sargent's haunting portrait of Terry as Lady Macbeth is drawn.
