## **Checklist Questions**

- Does the manuscript address the question?
- Have the authors provided sufficient methodological detail that the experiments could be reproduced?
- Is the statistical analysis of the data sound?
- Are the figures and tables correct and informative?
- Should the authors be asked to provide further data or methodological information to help others replicate their work? (Such data might include source code for modelling studies, detailed protocols or mathematical derivations)
- Are there any special ethical concerns arising from the use of animals or human subjects?
- Have prior studies/data/references been appropriately used and acknowledged? N.B. You can request a plagiarism check if you have concerns.
