## About the booklet

Guess What! Home Booklet has interesting and fun activities, including cross-curricular topics (CLIL), designed to encourage children's curiosity about the world, while they learn to communicate in English. It also provides opportunities for children to develop their social skills by exploring values and emotions, as well as the basic competences necessary in Primary Education, following the National Curriculum for the teaching of English in Spanish primary schools.

## The characters

In Levels 1 and 2 the units are based around the Fun Family. They introduce the unit to the children by asking them to find a hidden object.

## VISUAL MAP

Enjoy the unit poem at home with this activity. Your child reads the poem and does the activity.

This activity practises vocabulary and grammar. After finishing the activity, encourage your child to read out his/her answers. You can also ask him/her questions, or encourage him/her to say sentences about themselves, as appropriate.

This activity recaps on different emotions. Your child will do it with the 'help' of a friendly alien called Alan. Ask your child to show you his/her answers. You can also talk about situations when your child may feel that emotion, and positive ways to handle it.

This second page is focused on interesting cross-curricular (CLIL) topics. You can ask your child questions about the pictures - or you may tell your child to ask you some questions!
