## About the booklet

Guess What! Home Booklet has interesting and fun activities, including cross-curricular topics (CLIL), designed to encourage children's curiosity about the world, while they learn to communicate in English. The third page includes a guided writing activity for a different type of text that follows the model of the reading text.
